## **Please Read This Carefully – It Explains What You Need To Do**

To order plants in this year's Plant Sale please either use (preferably) the linked order form or send an email to [Rob.Greig2@btinternet.com](mailto:Rob.Greig2@btinternet.com) with **all** the following information.

1. Your name
2. Your phone number (preferably a mobile for contacting by text)
3. Your address
4. Whether you want to pick up your order from Manor Stables or would like your plants delivered to you. We are happy to arrange either.
5. A list of the plants you would like to buy, detailing:
  - The Ref. No
  - Plant name
  - Quantity wanted (please read the comments for each plant. Some are coming in pots or strips of a defined number and so will be sold in those quantities. Be clear whether your number relates to individual plants or strips).
  - If you are wanting a particular type of a plant where there are different varieties available, state whether you will accept a different variety if the one you want has already sold out.
6. Whether you will be paying by credit card when you collect or through on-line banking. If neither are possible for you, we can arrange to pay by cash/cheque.

If you do not have email, phone on 837878 – but please **only** do this if you cannot use email.

### **ORDERS MUST BE SENT IN AND RECEIVED BY 5PM ON WEDNESDAY 5<sup>th</sup> May.**

Orders will be ready on either **Saturday 8<sup>th</sup>** or **Sunday 9<sup>th</sup>**. If you are collecting then we will text or call you with a time of day for you to collect that will avoid several people arriving at the same time. Deliveries will be made that day and left outside your front door.

Please note:

- Most plants are small having been grown from seeds or cuttings and are not the fully grown item. This year's growing conditions have been challenging, with cold nights and no rain, so some (especially veg and annuals) may be smaller than usual. However, they will all be viable plants – they will just take longer to achieve full potential. Prices will be amended to reflect this where plants are small.
- Priority will initially be given to orders from Hort. Soc members, until the last two days of ordering (Tuesday and Weds) when non-member orders will be processed.
- We cannot guarantee to supply everything you ask for as it will depend upon the level of demand and last minute growing conditions. If there is excess demand, plants will be allocated as fairly as possible (broadly first come first served, but not allowing one person to buy up all of a particular plant if others want it too).

Prices are not given here because prices might vary dependent upon the size/growth of each plant and won't know that until they are received the day before collection. Prices will be basically the same as last year – i.e. much less than the cost at garden centres. You'll have to trust us! If your plants are being delivered rather than you collecting them, you will be sent an email with the total price of your purchase and details of how to pay.
